This Miracle Mile-situated gallery's latest exhibition joins two artists with radically different approaches to the aesthetic of assemblage. Asad Faulwell, recent recipient of an MFA from Claremont Graduate School, creates intricate, large-scale collage paintings inspired by the political structures of the Middle East, where he has roots. This knotty subject matter becomes lovely and elegant through the artist's ornate, delicate handiwork.
